Dear Camp Applicant/Camp Counselor/Volunteer,

The time has come for another exciting week of fun at the Arc Summer Inclusion Camp on Casper Mountain. Camp will again be held at the Lions Camp for the Blind, and we are looking forward to having another great group of campers!

The Arc Summer Inclusion Camp is a day camp that will begin on July 23, 2018, and run through July 27, 2018. On the evening of July 27, 2018, there will be an overnight camp for children and young adults 12 years of age and older. Friends and family of campers are welcome to attend the night's festivities~ don't miss out on the food, dance, and late night fun!

The morning meeting place will be Shepherd of the Hills Presbyterian Church, located at 4600 South Poplar. All campers should arrive by 8:15 a.m. Buses and cars will leave the church at 8:30 a.m., and will return to the church parking lot at 5:00 p.m. Please ensure that you have arranged for prompt transportation from Shepherd of the Hills at the end of the day, as participants MUST be picked up no later than 5:00p.m.

On Friday afternoon, July 27th, campers will present their annual Arc Camp program for parents and friends. The program will begin at 2pm, and the campers always enjoy having a large audience! After the program you may purchase a camp T-shirt, order a camp video, and enjoy the complimentary food and drinks. **If you wish to take your camper with you after the program, please be sure to check your camper out with their counselor or staff!** This assists us in maintaining the health and safety of all participants and also ensures that all campers leave with the crafts that they created throughout the week.

Food and drinks will be provided throughout the day for all campers. However, if your camper has special dietary needs, please be sure to send those items.

There is a small fee to attend camp, as well as the usual **requirement** of becoming a member of The Arc of Natrona County to ensure coverage by The Arc's insurance policy. The cost for an individual to attend camp and for their membership is \$25 and \$45 for a family (2+). This payment must be submitted with your completed camp application, as your camper can not be registered until payment is received. Please remember that no one is allowed at Arc camp without a current membership!

To ensure that your camper's health and safety needs are met, **all medications must be in their original containers. To maintain compliance with the Division's requirements for medication, there will be NO EXCEPTIONS, and medications that arrive in baggies, syringes, pillboxes, and med planners will not be allowed**. I, Bethany Young, will be available to check in medications each morning at the church parking lot, and paperwork will be completed upon transfer. Medications can be sent daily, or for the entire week. Please don't forget PRN medications if they are needed.

There will be a **mandatory** training for **all volunteers, staff members, independent providers and counselors** involved in The Arc Summer Inclusion Camp. **No one is exempt from this training**. Two training sessions will be held at The Arc. Please choose <u>one</u> of the following times to attend:

Monday – July 16^{th} @ 6:00 p.m. Saturday – July 21^{st} @ 2:00 p.m.

Applications need to be received NO LATER than Monday, July 17th, 2017 @ 5:00 p.m. *Please mark this date on your calendar, as all applications received after this deadline will not be accepted.*
