

CAMP RULES

- 1. All medications must be in their original, labeled containers, and given to the designated Arc staff prior to camp. It is the policy of The Arc of Natrona County to reject any medication provided in baggies, pill boxes, or medication planners (that are not labeled). Please plan accordingly and look for the vehicle accepting medications in the parking lot so you can check medications in.
- 2. All medication will be administered by an E.M.T., R.N. or certified Arc employee.
- 3. All medical treatment will be provided by an E.M.T., R.N., or certified Arc employee.
- 4. All campers, staff and volunteers are required to stay in designated areas with their assigned groups.
- 5. All campers will be treated with dignity and respect.
- 6. Only appropriate language is to be used.
- 7. Fighting or rough housing is not allowed.
- 9. If a problem should arise between anyone at any time, the situation will be taken to Arc of Natrona County administrative staff and will not be discussed with others.
- 10. The Executive Director has sole discretion to decide whether anyone should be sent home.
- 11. Complaints and compliments pertaining to the camp's operation are welcome, and will be documented by the Camp Director and/or Arc of Natrona County administrative staff and submitted to the Executive Director and the Board of Directors
- 12. All campers, volunteers, and staff are responsible for their own belongings. All belongings taken to the camp should be labeled prior to arrival at camp.
- 13. The primary responsibility of Arc staff is the well-being and safety of all campers.
- 14. Campers and staff will participate in all activities.
